Breckenridge

2,358 Skiable acres, 30 lifts, 300 inches annual snowfall, 14% Green, 60% Intermediate, 36% Expert,
Got Oxygen - Base 9,600 Summit 13,000 ft, 3,400 ft vertical rise

Vail

Vail boasts three distinct areas of the mountain, each with their own features and fortes, including three terrain parks, seven bowls and 5,289 acres of free-ride terrain. At seven miles wide, finding fresh tracks is as easy as finding elbow room. In fact, on an average day, there are only two skiers per acre. (*transportation included*)

Beaver Creek

331 inches of annual snowfall, 1805 acres, 650 with snowmaking, 17 lifts
Top elevation 11,440 feet, base 7,400 feet; 34% beginner, 39% intermediate, 27% advanced.

A-Basin

The mountain stands tall with a summit elevation of 13,050 feet, blanketed in fresh snow. From the base it invites you, calm and silent. Over a hundred trails expertly carved through its depths and serviced by seven chairlifts
