 - One grilled kosher style hot dog on a bakery fresh bun with ketchup, mustard, relish & onions

FAQ About Orioles Bullpen Party and Game- Sunday, June 27, 2010

What time does the ballpark open?

The ballpark will open at 11:30 a.m.

Where is the Bullpen Picnic Area?

The Bullpen Picnic Area is behind the opposing team's bullpen, between Camden Street Gate G and Eutaw Street Gate H. (Gate H is right by the Sports Legends Museum and the Babe Ruth statue.)

What time is the Bullpen Party?

The Bullpen Party starts at 12:00 p.m. and will end at 1:30 p.m., just prior to the start of the game. Once the game starts, no more "free" food or beverage will be available. Remember, over 2/3 of your ticket price for the game was for the Bullpen Party, so you don't want to miss it! There are no refunds if you are late.

Is there public transportation to Oriole Park at Camden Yards?

There are a variety of public transportation options for getting to the park, which are highly recommended. Details are here- <http://www.mtmaryland.com/services/sports/orioles/>. I use the Light Rail and it has always run smoothly.

What if I drive there? Where should I park?

General parking on a day of game basis is available in Lots F, G, and H. Subject to availability, limited parking may be offered in Lot B and C on a first-come, first-served basis. Off-site, over 30,000 spaces are located in garages and lots throughout the downtown/Inner Harbor area within one mile of Oriole Park.

Accessible parking spaces have been reserved for disabled season ticket holders utilizing equal access seating. The remaining accessible parking spaces are available on a first-come first-served basis. Spaces are located in Lots A & B and are clearly marked. There are also three drop off points which are located at: the Breezeway area of the Warehouse; Schaefer Circle off of the Russell Street Service Drive; Camden Street near Gate G. Is anyone carpooling?

What if it rains?

Games are played rain or shine. In the event that a game is officially postponed due to rain, tickets for that game will be considered rain checks. Rainout policies vary based on the situation. A policy will be announced after the game is officially postponed. Any game suspended after five innings (or 4 ½ innings if the Orioles are ahead) is considered a complete game. Suspended game tickets cannot be exchanged.
