CRAB FEAST 2009



The annual CSC crab feast has been scheduled for **Sunday 13 Sept from 1200-5:00 at Ft Meade, MD -[Burba Lake Cottage](#)**. The cottage holds 150 people, therefore only 150 tickets will be sold. If it rains, there is not problem, we are in the cottage. If the weather is good, no problem we are in the cottage. Outside of the cottage is a softball field, a beautiful lake to walk around, and an area for games. **This is a new location, with special security procedures.** So please before you start sending e-mail asking lots of questions, read this entire flyer.

Menu consists of many bushels of crabs, many pounds of shrimp, lots of barbequed chicken, corn on the cob, salads, hamburgers, hot dogs, and desserts.

Pricing:

If you are **eating seafood** -that consists of crabs and shrimp, just crabs, or just shrimp the cost per person is **\$37.00**.

If you are **not eating any seafood**, no crabs, no shrimp, the cost is **\$22.00** per person.

The price also includes: sodas, beer, water, door prizes and of course our very own Ken will be providing CD music for your listening and possibly dancing pleasure. There will also be raffle tickets on sale for wonderful baskets filled with great stuff.

[Burba Lake](#) is located at Ft. Meade which is just east of Columbia on Rt. 175. I would suggest you take RT 175 from Columbia. Once you arrive Ft. Meade, to enter the Ft. you will be required to go through a guarded gate house. **When you purchase your ticket for the crab feast, you will be required to provide your full name as shown on your identification card. – which you MUST bring on Sept. 13th.** Also you will need to provide the **full names of everyone you are purchasing tickets for.** I have to provide the list of attendees to the Ft. Meade Security at least two weeks before the event.

No tickets will be sold after 30 Aug. No exceptions! Tickets are **not transferable** due to the security procedures for entering Ft. Meade. 150 tickets will be sold on a first come first pay basis. Again, no ticket transferring is allowed. No parking on seeded or grass areas; see [Rules](#).

Stand by, there just might be an appearance from the snow cone machine.

If you can not attend the general meeting this Monday night, please send a check, made out to the **Columbia Ski Club** for the amount of attendees. **Specify seafood/no seafood and all attendees identification information.**
